Nelson Martelle of SHKS introduction

- Nelson gave introduction of who he is and what work will be done. He stated first part of the entire RFP could be completed within a two-month window.
- Kurt asked what kind of work does SHKS usually deal with. SHKS is primarily a architectural design office and subcontracts when necessary
- Nelson says the floor surprised him the most because there was no obvious enveloping. He is curious to see if floor damage is from unvented crawl space
- This phase of the project will not ruin the Schoolhouse's grant timeline. Most grants application windows begin in late summer to early fall
- It was asked if SHKS could enter below the floor from crawl space? Since floor is buckled it may be able to crawl under
- If phase 1 ends by end of April, then remaining phases (if funding is approved by Selectboard) could be finished 2-4 months after that. So mid-summer timeline for the completing entire RFP.
- Monica says historical society has a photo of an older interior photo with the school that may be beneficial to SHKS
- If Town has any additional schematics of electrical please send to Nelson
- Electricity has been cut so has the heating, septic has also been disconnected. Septic can be reattached to town office tank
